The Lawrence Photo Alliance (LPA) was founded in 1984 to serve as a network for sharing interests, skills and tips, to organize exhibits, and to promote the art of photography. The original group had 20 members. Today's members are not only from Douglas County and the Kansas City area, but from all over Kansas.

The purpose of the organization, as stated in the By-Laws adopted on July 3, 1990, is to provide opportunities in photography pursuant to group interaction, networking, community involvement, exchanging technical and artistic ideas, and exhibiting.

MEETINGS

Our monthly meetings, which form the core activities of our organization and are usually held in either the Lawrence Arts Center or the Lawrence Public Library, typically includes informative presentations by local artists and technical experts in all areas of photography. Recent topics have included a demonstration of hand coloring photographs, a discussion of large format cameras, presentations of framing and mounting, studio lighting, toning, and computers and photography.

NEWS

The LPA keeps members informed via email, a web site, and meeting reminder postcards, of upcoming photo competitions, juried shows and exhibitions in the area, in addition to the LPA's own activities.

DAY TRIPS

Occasionally we have field trips to explore news areas to photograph, such as the Baker Wetlands, the Flint Hills and the Z-Bar Ranch, the Garden of Eden, Pomona Lake, and the train station in Baldwin.

ANNUAL EVENTS

We have several annual LPA events: a group picnic late Spring or early Summer, and a holiday dinner and print exchange in December.

EXHIBITIONS

Group exhibitions are mounted several times a year. We have exhibited at Art in the Park, Harvest of Arts, the University of Kansas, the Lawrence Arts Center, Lawrence Public Library, the Aardvark Gallery in Baldwin, the United Way Offices, Borders Bookstore, the Paradise Cafe, and other Lawrence, Topeka, and Kansas City locations.

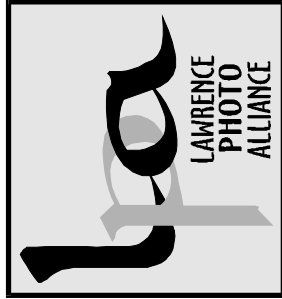
MEMBERSHIPS
